Previously she has served for example in the Unit for Global Communications as Director, Unit for Russia as Deputy Director and Unit for Northern Europe as desk officer for the Baltic states. Her career in the Diplomatic Service includes post at the Embassy of Finland in Riga, Latvia.

Laaksonen was born in Pori, Finland in 1975. She graduated from the University of Helsinki in 2000 with a Master's Degree in Arts (Finnish and Scandinavian history). She has also studied Public Law in the University of Tampere.
