Mr Arto Haapea is Director of the Unit for East and Southeast Asia and Oceania at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland (since August 2020), covering Finland's bilateral relations with 29 countries and The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).

He served previously as Minister Counsellor, Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassy of Finland in New Delhi (2019–2020), and as Deputy Director and Team Leader for East Asia (2017–2019).

He has also served as Senior Adviser to the Ambassador of the European Union to People's Republic and China and Mongolia, and as Political Counsellor at the EU Delegation in Beijing (2015–2017). Prior to that, he was Deputy Consul General of Finland in Shanghai (2011–2015).

Since joining the Finnish MFA, he has also served as Legal Adviser at the Permanent Mission to the UN in New York (2008–2011), at the Embassy in The Hague (2007–2008), and as Deputy Adviser to the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development and European Affairs during Finland's rotating EU Presidency (2006).

Before his diplomatic career, Mr Haapea worked as Publishing Manager at Edita Publishing Plc. He holds a Master's degree in Law from the University in Helsinki.
