Her first two decades of diplomatic service concentrated on European affairs, including postings in Embassies in Paris and the Hague as well as eight years at Finland's Permanent Representation to the EU (2008- 2016) including management and coordination roles as the Deputy Permanent Representative (Coreper I Ambassador) and Antici Counsellor. Between 2003-2005 Ms Nissilä served as Diplomatic Advisor to the Minister for Foreign Affairs.

Ms Nissilä joined the Foreign Ministry in 1996. Her education includes Maîtrise en Politique Internationale from Université Libre de Bruxelles and Bachelor of Social Sciences in International Relations from University of Tampere.
