Before his current position Ambassador Anttinen was the Ambassador of Finland to Nepal (2018–2022). He has also worked as the Ambassador of Finland to Zambia (accredited to Zimbabwe and Malawi) as well as the Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassies of Finland in South Africa, Ireland and Türkiye.

In the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Helsinki Ambassador Anttinen has had various positions of which most recent have been Senior Adviser at the Department of Africa and the Middle East and Director of the Unit for Sector Policy at the Department for Development Policy. Before joining the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in 1991, he worked as researcher and two years at the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP).

Ambassador Anttinen was born in Jyväskylä, Finland in 1960. He graduated from the University of Helsinki, Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry in 1986.
