Recognition of qualifications

- If you wish to work in Finland in a regulated profession you will need a decision on recognition of your qualification made by competent authority.
 - both establishment & temporary and occasional provision of services
- If your qualification was recognised before 1 January 2021 you don't need to do anything. The decision on recognition of your qualification will remain valid.

 - Finnish National Agency for Education (Opetushallitus)
- Healthcare and Social welfare professions
 - National Supervisory Authority for Welfare and Health (Valvira)
- Professions related to animals and food safety
 - Finnish Food Authority (Ruokavirasto)
- Transport
 - Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (Traficom)
- Advocate, <u>Finnish Bar Association</u> (Asianajajaliitto)
- Auditor, Finnish Patent and Registration Office (Patentti ja rekisterihallitus)
