## Statement of Intent<sup>1</sup> for Cooperation on Digital Empowerment in Developing Countries between the U.S. Agency for International Development and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland

The United States of America and the Republic of Finland share values of democracy, human rights, and the rule of law. They are both committed to improving the competitiveness, productivity and well-being of their respective societies by strengthening cooperation in innovation, technology, and research, especially in emerging and disruptive technologies, such as fifth- and sixth-generation (5G and 6G) wireless network technology, artificial intelligence, robotics, quantum computing, and blockchain.

The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) expresses its intent to work with relevant Finnish government agencies, non-governmental organizations, and companies to strengthen U.S.-Finland cooperation on digital empowerment in partner countries. USAID intends to work with other relevant U.S. Government agencies to advance the purposes and objectives of this Statement of Intent. Likewise, the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland intends to cooperate with relevant agencies in Finland.

We, USAID and the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland, intend to work together by providing financing, technical assistance on strategy development, implementation, and policy advice, as appropriate and subject to the availability of funds, to governments, civil society, and the private sector in interested partner countries to facilitate inclusive digital transformation in line with the Sustainable Development Goals, whereby their citizens can take advantage of all the benefits and opportunities of an open, secure, and inclusive digital ecosystem. In particular, we commit to advancing the full rights and agency of women and girls in the digital ecosystem through the Generation Equality Action Coalition on Technology and Innovation for Gender Equality.

Through transparent regulations and market-driven policies, we intend to help partner countries build a level playing field and mobilize the full force of usable data and market solutions to facilitate digital empowerment. In collaboration with enterprises and other relevant stakeholders from both public and private sectors in our respective countries, we intend to support capacity building, technical and regulatory assistance, and support innovative solutions to advance the digital ecosystem.

We intend to advance digital best practices by drawing upon the best practices in digitalization and network development, as stated for example in the EU Toolbox for 5G Security, the Digital Government Toolkit of the Organization for Economic Co-Operation and Development (OECD)<sup>2</sup> and the Principles for Digital Development. We intend to work locally, regionally and globally towards forming wider partnerships of like-minded donors to bring our efforts to scale.

We, the undersigned, dedicate ourselves to robust collaboration on these efforts.
