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INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FOR ADVANCE INFORMATION

Mandatory data fields on the application form are marked in red. In addition to the mandatory data, you are only required to provide the details that are needed for supplying the advance information.

1 Exporter

Give the name, address, phone number and Business ID of the exporter (7+1 digits).

5 Consignee

Give all details of the consignee as accurately as possible. You can add or remove names of consignees using the +/- keys on the right.

8 Country of origin (if necessary)

Select the country and its country code from the dropdown menu. You only need to complete the field if the items for which you need advance information have been imported to the EU customs territory from a third country. If there is more than one description of items, give the country of origin for each of them.

9 Country of consignment (if necessary)

Select the name of the country and its country code from the dropdown menu. You only need to complete the field if the items for which you need advance information have been imported to the EU customs territory from a third country. The country of consignment may be different than the country of origin. If there is more than one description of items, give the country of consignment for each of them.

11 Member State in which the items are currently located or in which they will be located in the future

Click the dropdown menu to select the EU Member State in which the items are currently located or in which they will be located when finished. If there is more than one Member State of location, enter all of them in the 'Additional information' field. Give also the address in an EU Member State where the items are/will be located.

12 Member State in which the items will be placed under an export procedure

Click the dropdown menu to select the EU Member State in which the items will be placed under an export procedure.

13 Final country of destination

This field will be completed automatically when you give the details of the consignee (field 5).

14 Description of the items

Describe the items subject to controls and their model. Give the name normally used for the items for trading purposes. It must be possible to recognise the items unambiguously on the basis of the description. You can add and remove item fields using the +/- keys on the right.

15 CAS number

If the items are chemicals or chemical mixtures, give their CAS number (Chemical Abstract Number).

16 Classification number

Enter the classification number given in Annex I to the EU regulation 428/2009 (for example, 3A001a1a). Note that Annex I is regularly updated. The exporter (if necessary, with the assistance of the manufacturer) is responsible for entering the correct classification on the application. You can also request information about the classification of the items from the Ministry for Foreign Affairs. The request must be made in writing on a separate form. Give CA as the classification, if the items have been placed under export control at the national level (catch all decision) and no separate classification number has been allocated to them.

17 Currency and value of the items

Give here the currency used and the value of the items. If there is more than one piece of the same item, give their total value. If there is more than one description of items, give the currency used and the value of each of the items.

Total export value

Give the total export value in euros (EUR).

18 Quantity

Give here the quantity. Select the quantity from the dropdown menu.

19 End use

Give a description of the intended use of the items.

22 Additional information

Give here any additional information that you consider necessary.

Inquiry about the use of export items

Answer 'Yes' if you are aware that the items exported in this shipment will be used for the development of weapons of mass destruction.

Inquiry about the use of export items

List the appendices on the form.

Contact person

Give the name and phone number of the person in charge of the application process.
