

## List of airlines operating flights out of Cambodia

Last updated: 17th April at 09:30 (Phnom Penh time)

### Travel restrictions:

Effective since 30 March 2020, 23:59 local time, all **Foreign inbound travelers** into Cambodia must have a medical certificate issued by the competent health authorities of their country no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel and certifying that they are not tested positive for the Coronavirus (COVID - 19), as well as a proof of insurance policy with minimum medical coverage of fifty thousand US dollars. Passengers arriving from France, Germany, Iran, Italy, Spain or USA are not allowed to enter Cambodia.

### Direct flights:

There is no direct flight to Europe from Cambodia. Flights to Europe remain possible through the following connections:

Airline	Status	Destinations	Observations
Korean Air	Reduced to 2 flights a week from PNH to Seoul, on Fridays and Sundays, and until 30 April 2020 and from 1 to 31 May	Seoul Incheon (ICN)	CAUTION - Continuation from Korean or Asiana on BA or Qatar may require a multi-ticket (2 different tickets issued) and it is possible that check-in luggage is not permitted to avoid leaving the transit area
Asiana	Still operates 4 flights a week from PNH to Seoul, on Mondays, Wednesdays (except 20 to 27 April), Fridays and Sundays, and until 30 April 2020 and will operate 3 flights a week on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays from 1 to 31 May		

**NOTE:** Although most of the flights are fully booked, there is a chance for passengers to stand by at the airport as seats are usually available due to no shows. Please notify the check-in staff at least 2 hours before the counter closes so that you have sufficient time to get the tickets issued.

### No longer flying/other restrictions

ANA	All Nippon Airlines has suspended its flights to NRT from 12 to 24 April (ANA notification, 28 March 2020) and from 25 April to 31 May (ANA notification 15 April 2020)
China	Transit restriction: No transit allowed anymore since 28 March 00:00 local time (IATA travel center, update 26.03.2020)
Hong Kong	Transit restrictions. Effective from 25 March 2020 (00:00 HKT.), all transiting through Hong Kong International Airport will be suspended.
Emirates	The UAE government <a href="#">suspended</a> all flights for 14 days as of 25 March.
Qatar Airways	Qatar airways has suspended its flight Doha – PNH effective on 1st April 2020 and until 1 June 2020
Malaysian Airlines	Although MH755 is still scheduled on 3, 10, 12, 17, 19 and 26 April, the 3 April flight is already canceled (MH website) and the others are likely to follow In addition, transit through KUL still permitted but not between terminals (The Guardian, 24 March)
Singapore	Short-term visitors not allowed to visit or transit through Singapore from 11.59 pm on 23 March
Taiwan	Closed to transfer since 24 March, for at least 2 weeks (Taiwan News, 22 March)
Thailand	All flights to BKK suspended on Thai Airways (last Thai Airways flight on 27 March 2020), Thai Smile, Bangkok Airways, Cambodia Airways, Lanmei and JC International Airlines
Vietnam	All flights to Hanoi and HCM City suspended (except QR 971 until 31 March)
