**Sub: Movement of Indian Nationals to travel abroad**

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of External Affairs' email dated 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 on the subject cited above and to say that the para 2 (ii) of Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for movement of persons stranded in India who are desirous to travel abroad issued vide MHA order of even number dated 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 is modified as under :

Only those persons shall be allowed to travel to the destination countries, who are citizens of that country; who have a green card or OCI card; Indian Nationals who are holding visa of that country, with a minimum residual validity of three months. In case an Indian National is having confirmed offer of employment / internship / admission in education institution, he/ she can be allowed with visa of that country, with a minimum residual validity of one month.
